## 本校成績概況

### 入讀本地大學學士課程概要

去年超過四分之三學生能入讀本地大學學士學位課程。

入讀之學系分別有：醫學、法律、言語及聽覺科學、保險及財務與精算學、風險管理科學、專業會計學、中醫、物理治療、經濟與金融、工程、工商管理、社會工作、教育、幼兒教育及護理等。

### 第十屆香港中學文憑考試

除中國語文、中史、中國文學外，全部科目(包括通識教育科)均以英語應考。全部科目取得2-5\*\*級別成績平均為99%，取得4-5\*\*級別成績平均為54%。中國語文、英國語文、數學必修部份和通識教育科四個核心科目取得2-5\*\*級別成績平均接近100%，取得4-5\*\*級別成績平均為54.2%。生物科成績優異，取得4-5\*\*級別成績為82.6%，取得5-5\*\*級別成績為47.8%。

## 2021-2022中一自行分配學位座談會暨開放日


### 家長與學生參觀本校設施

「我從香港奧運運動員身上學習到」徵文比賽

## 「我從香港奧運運動員身上學習到……」

「只要努力不放棄，大家都會做到。」，「只要努力都可以有好成績。」，這些都是香港奧運運動員的金句。金句中體現出每位香港奧運運動員都有一股熱忱以及鍥而不捨的精神。其中我最佩服單車運動員李慧詩，她把「鍥而不捨」這四個字表現得淋漓盡致，也是她讓我學習到什麼是鍥而不捨的精神……

「砰！」只見我又從單車上跌了下來。「兒子你怎麼樣，你怎麼樣……」媽媽慌張地跑過來詢問我的情況，如坐針氈。我沮喪地說：「媽媽，學單車很難，每次都會跌倒，很痛啊！我不想再學了。」說到這裏我眼眶泛紅，黯然神傷。媽媽沉默了一會，然後說：「乖，我先帶你去包紮，等會兒再說這事。」我點頭答應，小心翼翼地站起來，並步履蹣跚地走去醫療室。

回到家裏，我坐在沙發上看到一個關於香港運動員的電視節目——李慧詩的介紹。我倍感興趣，因為李慧詩是單車運動員；但又有點失落，因為我對單車產生了「陰影」。就這樣懷着複雜的心情看下去。

「李慧詩生於香港，在牛頭角下邨長大，有『牛下女車神』之稱。李慧詩的「不死精神」一直被香港人視為榜樣。她自幼患有貧血，每次進行高強度訓練或比賽後，需要比其他人的恢復時間。2006年，她在一次訓練中意外翻車導致手腕骨裂，曾三度手術失敗。因此，教練沈金康曾勸她退役，但被她拒絕，在養傷期間仍堅持訓練。其努力令她在2010年亞洲運動會中打破亞洲紀錄，贏得金牌。」

看到這裏，我心裏頓時感到羞愧：一個女子遇到那麼多挫折和疾病，卻能夠堅持自己的夢想努力下去，而我沒病沒痛，只是經歷了小小的挫折就放棄……想到這裏我就越發慚愧，而媽媽也察覺到我的變化，於是「乘虛而入」：「現在你還要不要學單車？」「要！」我擦乾眼淚，笑着說：「我要努力下去，好像李慧詩一樣出色！」

## 一顆大豆的故事

大豆不論是在遠久的古代還是現代，都一直深受人們喜愛。大豆現在相當普遍，遍佈全世界，幾乎能處處看到大豆和其豆製品。經常能接觸大豆的你，又是否了解大豆呢？

我是一顆普通的大豆種子，自發芽起便和兄弟姐妹們一起待在土裡，一天一天成長。我們大豆屬於五穀之一，五穀分別是稻、麥、黍、小米和大豆。五穀起源自我國遠古的春秋戰國，當時我們並不叫大豆，而是「菽」，由那時起，我們便被人們種植食用。在宋朝的時候，大豆已經很普遍，人們已習以為常，並都處種植。人們在我們成熟後會把我們造成不同製品，例如當時盛行的豆腐等。到了明朝，豆的種植和種類便完全成熟，而現在大豆的種植面積不斷增加，大豆一直深受人們喜愛。

從發芽到成熟真是一段難熬又無聊的時光。自發芽起的每一天，我和兄弟姐妹百無聊賴地待在土裡。北方的氣候很適合豆類生長，太陽幾乎每天都會為我們提供陽光，機器會為我們澆水，農夫們則會為我們提供營養又美味的肥料，供給我們成長所需。當有蟲災的時候，農夫會為我們灑上化學農藥，防止我們被蟲吃掉；豆田的周圍亦有一些高大的稻草人，保護我們不被鳥兒吃掉。我們大豆的成長要求很少，不用太多條件和肥料，加上產量高，製品種類多，因此吸引了不少農夫種植。

發芽後大概三、四個月，我們便會成熟，成為一顆可以供人類食用的大豆。大豆的抗病力很強，而且大豆含豐富蛋白質，足以媲美肉類，而大豆和同份量的肉類相比，所含的蛋白質比肉類高出約兩倍。大豆能造成的豆製品隨著時間推移越來越多，例如豆腐和豆漿。在經過加工後，我們更可以被做成醬油、味噌、納豆等，而餘下的豆渣或磨成粗粉的大豆也可以用於禽畜飼料，用處非常多。我們大豆的營養價值也非常高，具有清熱解毒、益氣等功效。

近年，人們發明了基因改造。經過基因改造的大豆，有一些能抗農藥或除草劑，但是現在的人並不贊同基因改造，因為人們認為經過基因改造的大豆會危害人類的健康，甚至在全球各地不接受基因改造大豆。其實，在各國基因改造食品都被法例規管，規定基因改造食品必須經過規管機構的安全評估及批准，才可在市面出售，因此在市面出售的基因改造大豆對人體絕無健康影響。此外，現時全球的大豆需求不斷大幅增加，由一九五零年的一千七百噸增至二零一零年的二億多噸。若果我成熟後被帶到世界各地，我最希望能被做成醬油或豆腐，因為這兩種食品最為普遍，且較多人喜歡食用。

作為一顆大豆的我，供人類食用是我的職責。雖然很多事情會隨著時間改變，但「粒粒皆辛苦」這一點是不會變的，希望人們能好好珍惜食物，不要浪費。

## 人工智能Edge-級方程式賽車比賽

由智慧城市聯盟主辦和STEM Plus協辦的「校際人工智能Edge-級方程式賽車比賽」，已在12月10日至12日，一連三日於亞洲國際博覽館舉行，首屆有21間學校逾70隊參加，約300位學生參與這項比賽。本校中三至中四級學生分別組成三隊隊伍參賽，各隊均有出色的表現，當中中三級學生更於是此比賽奪得冠軍（Jetbot Champion），而中四級學生則勇奪Jetbot Best Single Lap Time 及 Best Team Name Champion獎項。AI E-級方程式賽車是透過人工智能去學習無人駕駛，用家需要透過輸入精準的相片，令系統可以辨識路線。是次比賽增加學生對人工智能技術的認知，鼓勵他們在創科路上繼續學習。

## iGEM 國際遺傳工程機器設計競賽

國際遺傳工程機器設計競賽（英語：International Genetically Engineered Machine Competition, iGEM）是一年一度的世界級的合成生物學競賽，由麻省理工學院於2004年首創，旨在培養合成生物學人才，促進各國大學本科生在該領域的學習、交流與合作。本校於今屆iGEM競賽中，勇奪銅獎，過程中透過與香港科技大學合作、校內培訓、STEAM研發、安排學生出席交流會及於公開場合演說等，培養學生科學素養並拓展其國際視野。提升學生將來在科研領域發展的潛力。

**Other Learning Experiences Week (OLE)**

In line with the requirement of the 3-3-4 new education system in the aspect of Other Learning Experiences, a 4-day programme which aimed at fostering students' all-round development, including extra-curricular activities, services and moral values, was organized in mid-December. Students were engaged in the programme dubbed as 'Other Learning Experiences Week'.

More than forty theme activities were held by all subjects. For example, through a visit to China Light & Power Company (CLP) and Low Carbon Energy Education Centre, the Chemistry Department helped students understand the importance of low carbon energy so as to address the environmental challenges. A variety of activities were conducted by the Career and Life Planning Committee, namely coffee brewing and latte art workshop; and creative digital media design on mobile apps. A visit to an insurance company helped students get the first-hand experience of duties of the insurance industry from the sharing session of the representatives. Through the visits to the Mills and Mei Ho House, the Personal, Social and Humanities Education Department encouraged students to explore the continuity of an authentic Hong Kong story and to understand the evolution of public housing.

In 2021-2022, small class teaching has been carried out across different forms in the college. More than 10 additional teachers and teaching assistants have been recruited to further reduce the teacher-student ratio in multiple subjects to raise the quality of teaching and learning.

**Authentic English Learning**

To foster a rich English speaking environment with authentic English materials, the English Department has devised a comprehensive scheme. Interactive activities with native English speakers during English Day Camp can enhance students' English proficiency. In after-school activities, namely Chill Time and Fly with Me, in which songs and videos are broadcast, students can learn vocabulary and idioms used in real-life contexts. Students are also encouraged to utilize their electronic gadgets to get access to news online before discussions with classmates.

## STEAM - paving the way for the future

STEAM is an approach based on the idea of educating students in specific disciplines, namely Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics.

In cooperation with the Chinese University of Hong Kong, the Coral Cultivation Workshop held last December is part of a project to conserve corals on campus. The corals cultivated by our students will eventually be transplanted to Tolo Harbour to assist in the restoration of coral communities.

Students measure the water quality once a week and keep a record of coral growth once a month. All data will be uploaded to the database of the Chinese University of Hong Kong.



This is the fourth year that our school has participated in this project. Through the workshop, students learned to take an active role in conservation, which also encouraged them to take greater responsibility for environmental protection.

## A Lifelong Process of Career Development

The Career and Life Planning Committee organised a wide variety of activities in the first term of this academic year. With the aim of engaging students in different learning experiences, the activities encouraged self-discovery among students and helped them explore possible career paths.

In junior forms, the activities and workshops aimed to promote self-discovery before selecting their electives in the senior forms. In senior forms, the workshops and talks focused on career planning, allowing students to have a better understanding of the job nature and prospects of different industries.




